## Big John's Market - A Brief History

In 1994 Kim & John Lloyd came up from Southern California looking for the small town quality of life and a potential business opportunity and settled in Healdsburg, Sonoma County. They took over the former Deluxe Foods located at the intersection of Healdsburg Avenue and Dry Creek Road.



When asked about the name, John Lloyd quickly points out that "BIG JOHN" isn't a personal nickname. The "BIG" is an acronym for Better Independent Grocers.

Big John's Market serves the Healdsburg, Geyserville, Alexander Valley, and Dry Creek Valley areas as well as Cloverdale to the North and Windsor to the South.

In 2006, the building and fixtures were completely renovated bringing a fresh new look and adding a food service court and outdoor seating.

# Greyhound Football Through The Years



- 1897- HHS plays its first interscholastic football game against Petaluma High on Thanksgiving. Manager Fessy Griffith has a squad of 13 players. Petaluma wins.
- 1904- Coached by Dr. Kinley, the HHS squad beats Wilmerding High out of San Francisco by a score of 5-2. A field goal and safety was all that was needed.
- 1925- Led by Smith Robinson at halfback, HHS will play Analy, Vallejo, Ukiah, Santa Rosa, and Napa High Schools. The squad is coached by Prof. Raymond Scott and by the end of the season, the team is recognized as the best ever HHS team.
- 1947- Competing in Section II of the North Bay League, and watching St. Helena become champions in 1944, Sonoma in 1945, and Calistoga in 1946, Coach Art McCaffrey leads the Greyhounds to their first Championship going 7-0 during the season and beating undefeated Sonoma 14-6 to secure the title.
- 1957- "A dinner sponsored by the Healdsburg Chamber of Commerce, will take place tomorrow night, Friday, November 22, at the Villa Chanticleer. Healdsburg Greyhounds, who defeated the Ukiah Wildcats Friday night in an exciting tussle in Ukiah to win the North Bay League Section II League Championship, will be present at the dinner along with coaches Eugene Defillippis and Leroy Danhausen. The team will be presented with gold football replicas courtesy of the Healdsburg service clubs noting the 8-0 season." (Taken from the Healdsburg Tribune.)
- 1978- Healdsburg High's varsity football coach Tony Frye has been named Coach of the Year in the Sonoma County League. Frye has been the Greyhound coach for four years. The Hounds go 9-1-1 and make the NCS playoffs for the first time.
- 1988- In the Oakland Coliseum, the Greyhounds lose 14-7 to Kennedy High of Richmond in the NCS 2A Championship. A large contingent of Healdsburg fans cheered on their team which ended the season 11-2 in Coach Kirkpatrick's second season.
- 1991- Led by Coach Tom Kirkpatrick, the Hounds defeat Marin Catholic 21-7 at Bailey Field at SRJC to win their first NCS Championship going 11-2 for the season.
- 1998- Again led by Coach Tom Kirkpatrick, the Hounds defeat San Rafael 28-8 at Rec. Park to win their second NCS Championship going 10-3 for the season.

Since 1897, Healdsburg High football has weathered many challenges to its football program. In the early part of the Century, football was only played as an intramural sport and often only with 6 players. During some of the Depression years and in 1943, Healdsburg High School only played alumni games on Thanksgiving or 6 on 6 games with other schools. Since 1947, only two teams have gone undefeated and only three teams have gone winless. Since 1947, the Hounds have had 12 coaches at their helm and have won over 53% of their games. Football helps players learn to put others first, to be part of something bigger than themselves. Football players learn to lift their teammates – and themselves – up together. Go Hounds.
